PROHIBITED ITEMS

All spectators will be subject to random search. Any prohibited Items found shall be surrendered as a condition of entry.



ALL BAGS ARE SEARCHED

Your waiting time will be longer if you bring a bag. We will not permit large bags into the stadium, but small bags and handbags will be allowed. We class small bags as no larger than 35cm x 40cm x 19cm.

PAIRS

Tickets have been sold as pairs and you must sit in your designated seat



SOCIAL DISTANCING

- are unable to comply with any other restrictions or conditions introduced that apply

to attending a sporting event (where additional restrictions or conditions are introduced we will provide you with as much advance notice as possible)



EVENT PARK & RIDE CARDIFF EAST

PENTWYN INTERCHANGE - A48 (EASTERN AVENUE)

Getting There: Access from Junction 33 of the M4, then follow signage to site CF23 8HH

Drop Off Point: Fitzhammon Embankment, 2mins walk from stadium

Distance from City Centre: 1.5miles (10-15mins)

Cost: £8 Pre Book Online or £10 payable on the day at the car park (cash only)

If customers pre-book Park & Ride, they are required to print the pre booking confirmation and hand it to staff at site on arrival.

All P&R customers are advised to follow the signage to the site at the time of their arrival.

EVENT DAY PARKING AT SOPHIA GARDENS

Getting There: Exit Junction 32 of M4

Distance from City Centre: Approx. 0.5miles walk to Principality Stadium, Gate 2

Cost: £15 payable on the day at the car park (cash only)

Parking time: Car Park opens 8am and closes 12am (Midnight)

Please Note: Sophia Gardens car park will be staffed until 20.00, all vehicles are left on site at the owner's risk, The City of Cardiff Council will not be held responsible for any theft or damage to motor vehicles or personal possessions. Any vehicles left in the car park after the closing time will be fined.

DISABLED PARKING

Disabled drivers are advised to use Sophia Gardens. Disabled parking is also available at various private car parks. Please check individual websites for availability.

MOTORWAYS & TRUNK ROADS

As with all major events, ticket holders are encouraged to plan their travel well ahead and make allowances for busy motorways and trunk roads. The M4 corridor and approaches to Cardiff are expected to be very busy.

RAIL

Local Buses

Cardiff Bus is advising their customers that city centre services will be displaced due to road closures. Buses displaced from stops within the closure will relocate to either Churchill Way for the east, Greyfriars Road for the north or Tudor Street for the west.

CAN YOU CYCLE OR WALK?

Those who live locally in Cardiff may want to travel by bicycle or walk. Research shows us that 52% of car trips made in the Welsh capital are less than 5km. This is a distance that can be comfortably cycled in 20 minutes.

We also know that 28% of Cardiff residents who currently do not cycle would like to do so.

When the roads are congested this makes cycling an even more attractive option as travel by bicycle would be quicker than a car during rush hours or during big events.
